

House & Garden Alterations Edinburgh

Grandparents George and Maggie Ross moved back into Maggie's childhood home in Edinburgh's southside.

"It's a special house with lots of memories and I love being back. The house needed altering so that we could get more connection with the garden. We also wanted to make changes so that we could welcome our children and grandchildren when they come to stay".
